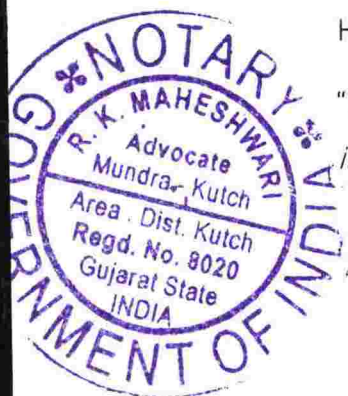

The Petitioner humbly submits as under:

1. MPSEZ Utilities Limited (hereinafter referred to as "MUL" or "Petitioner") has filed a petition for Compliance of the Gujarat Electricity Regulatory Commission (Procurement of Energy from Renewable Sources) Regulations, 2010, Gujarat Electricity Regulatory Commission (Procurement of Energy From Renewable Sources) (First Amendment) Regulations, 2014, Gujarat Electricity Regulatory Commission (Procurement of Energy From Renewable Sources) (Second Amendment) Regulations, 2018 notified by the Commission for fulfilment of RPO Obligation for FY 2019-20
2. The Petition was registered as Petition no. 1884/2020 vide Hon'ble Commission letter no. GERC/Legal/2020/0937 dated 27.08.2020.
3. The matter was kept for hearing by Hon'ble commission on 30.01.2021 and Petitioner was directed to publish the Notice in the newspapers according vide daily order dated 03.04.2021. The direction issued by Hon'ble commission is reproduced below:

"3.3. According to the Hon'ble APTEL's directions, it is necessary to issue a public notice and invite suggestions/objections from all the

stakeholders in the matter pertaining to compliance of RPO by the obligated entities. We note that the present Petition is filed for compliance of RPO target percentage from renewable energy sources for FY 2019-20 and to compensate shortfall of Solar RPO of FY 2017-18 with surplus Non-Solar RPO for FY 2019-20. Therefore, it deem necessary to conduct a public hearing to take into consideration the stockholders views before deciding the matter. The Petitioner is, therefore, directed to issue a public notice in two daily Gujarati Newspapers and one English Newspapers having wide circulation in the State/National level stating that they have filed Petition No. 1884 of 2020 before the Commission for compliance of RPO target for FY 2019-20 under the provision of GERC (Procurement of Energy from Renewable Energy Sources) Regulations, 2010 and its subsequent amendments thereto. The Petitioner is also directed to upload the present petition with all documents on its website and invite comments and suggestions from the stakeholders on the petition on affidavit within 21 days from the date of issuance of public notice. The Petitioner shall state in the public notice that the stakeholders/objectors shall file their objections/suggestions in the petition to the Secretary, Gujarat Electricity Regulatory Commission, 6th Floor, GIFT ONE, Road 5C, 3 Zone 5, GIFT City, Gandhinagar - 382355 in five copies along with affidavit in support of their submissions with a copy to the Petitioner. The staff of the Commission is also directed to upload the petition along with all relevant documents on the website of the Commission after compliance affidavit of issuing public notice and uploading of petition is filed by the Petitioner along with copy of public notices issued by the Petitioner is provided to the Commission and invite comments/suggestions from the stakeholders. "

4. The Petitioner has published the notice on 28.04.2021 in the newspapers inviting objections / suggestions from various stakeholders on its petition for RPO Compliance of FY 2019-20.

7. The Petitioner, therefore, submits that it has complied with the directions given in daily order by Hon'ble commission.

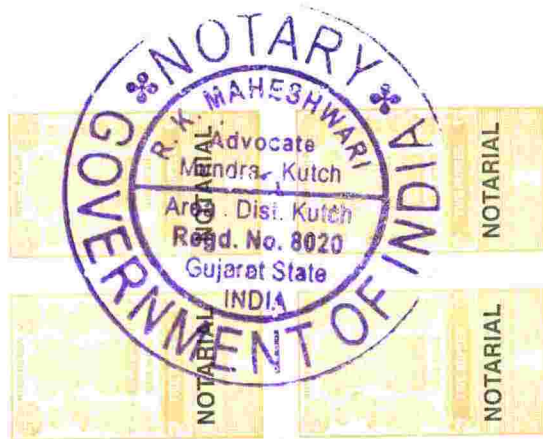

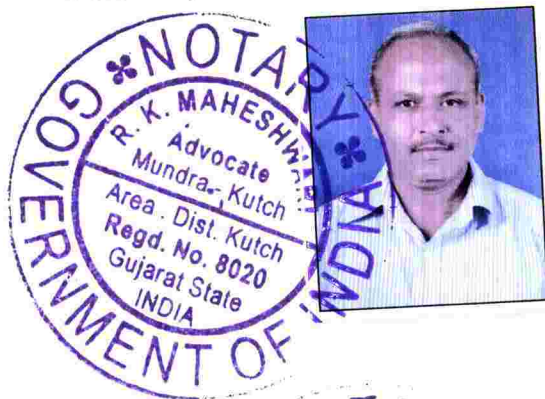
