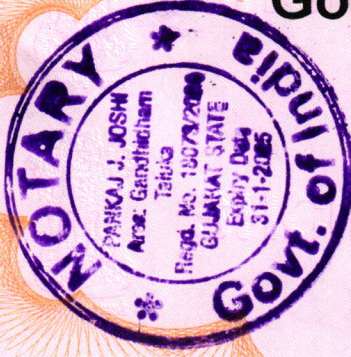

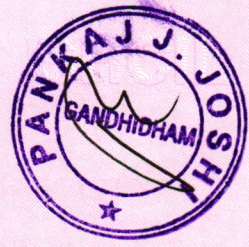

- a. I am the representative of Deendayal Port Authority and I am duly authorized to make this affidavit.
- b. That I am dealing with the sale/purchase of power on behalf of the applicant.
- c. I state that Deendayal Port Authority have consumed power from its own 6MW Wind power plant and balance power purchased power from PGVCL and Deendayal Port Authority have not procured power from any other source(s) during FY 2020-21.
- d. This is in reference to the daily order for petition no. 1992 of 2021 on 28st November 2022, regarding the submission of quarterly RPO Compliance report for FY 2020-21. The Power purchase from various sources is detailed below;

- e. Regarding the renewable purchase obligation for Quarter 1,2,3 & 4 of FY 2020-21, the Petitioner refers the Hon'ble Commission's Order in the matter of Suo-Motu Petition No. 1542 /2015, dated 31st December 2016, where in under Clause no. 15 the Hon'ble Commission has exempted DPT from compliance to RPO, on the grounds that DPT is procuring power, from PGVCL, which consists of the renewable energy component also. The relevant clause of the referred order has been reproduced below for reference:
- f. *"We also note that Jubilant Infrastructure Limited, GIFT Power Company Limited and Aspen Infrastructure Limited and Kandla Port Authority are procuring the power from the DGVCL, UGVCL, MGVCL and PGVCL respectively, which consists of the renewable energy component also. Therefore, we exempt them from the renewable purchase obligations specified by the Commission."*
- g. Now, the RPO targets applicable on power purchase from power exchange under open access in various quarters are calculated as below;

- h. As we can see from table 1 & 2 power procurement from Wind (Non-Solar) is very high in comparison to RPO requirement. Procurement of additional power from Solar energy will add on extra cost to DPT.
- i. In light of the above, As the Petitioner is procuring most of its energy requirement through renewable source of energy (wind power), thus it requests the Hon'ble

Shah was not present at the CCS meeting convened by PM Modi and attended by defence minister Rajnath Singh, home minister Amit Shah, finance minister Nirmala Sitharaman and foreign minister S Jaishankar. The safety of Indian nationals and diplomatic personnel figured prominently in the deliberations because of Hassan's "pro-India" image as well as the involvement of anti-India elements in the protests.

Jaishankar is likely to make a statement in Parliament on Tuesday.

had been stressing on joint efforts to counter terrorism and radicalisation and in their last summit in June, the two sides had agreed to explore defence industrial cooperation for modernisation of Bangla-

Fourth, the role of China in the dramatically altered geopolitical situation in Bangladesh will have to be closely followed. While maintaining strong economic ties with China, which is essential for the development and the financial expansion in January, Hasina had ensured Chinese investments did not impinge on India's security interests. Despite China's interest in the Ganges-Brahmaputra river dispute, Hasina was keen that India excite the project and her last meeting with Modi saw the Indian side agreeing to send a technical team to Bangladesh to examine a proposal for a dam on the Brahmaputra and the erosion of the river waters. With Hasina's exit, India will be worried about how the new govt will handle what both sides saw till now as shared strategic concerns and inter-

Successive Indian govts had an "all-encompassing" relationship with the Hasina govt that was based on trust, goodwill and respect for sovereignty, with the Indian ministry of external affairs hailing it a model for bilateral ties in the region and beyond.

Second, India will need to guard against any effort to fan regional unrest, including anti-India activities on Bangladesh's soil by foreign elements who have waited long to see the bark of Hasi-

na. India was faced with a similar situation in Afghanistan, much to Pakistan's jubilation, with the return of the Taliban in 2021 and although the regime in Kabul has been receptive to India's concerns so far, New Delhi continues to worry to follow reports about activities of Pakistan-based terror groups in Afghanistan.

Third, India will be worried about how counter-terrorism and defence cooperation with Dhaka might be affected. In his meetings with Hasina, PM Narendra Modi
