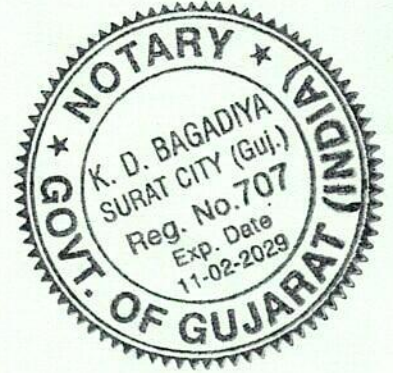
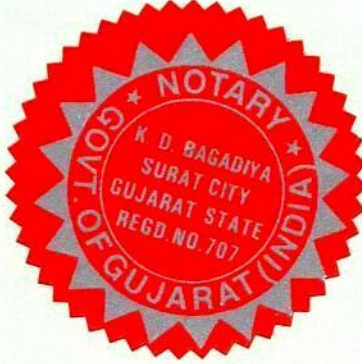

in compliance to Hon'ble Commission's Oral Order dated 20.12.2024 in Petition No. 2409 / 2024

PREAMBLE:

Petitioner has filed Petition no. 2409 of 2024 before this Hon'ble Commission seeking for adoption of tariff discovered under tariff based competitive bidding process conducted by DGVCL vide RfS No. DGVCL/C&R/DSM/PM-KUSUM-C FLS/TN-03Dtd.01.03.2024 for 64 Nos of solar plants of total 160.0 MW, through RESCO model, for solarization of various 11 KV feeders in DGVCL for implementation of FLS (Feeder Level Solarization) under PM KUSUM-C scheme of Government of India.

Accordingly, Hon'ble commission scheduled hearing on dtd. 13-12-2024 and passed daily order on dtd.20-12-2024 and directed the petitioner to file the response and to place the required documents on record within a period of 7 days from the date of this order



Accordingly, The Petitioner most respectfully and humbly submits the compliances directed by the Hon'ble commission as under;

1. In above oral order, Hon'ble commission placed on record the brief of petition under para-2 (i.e.2.1 to 2.8) and further noting / observations under para-3 (i.e.3.1 to 3.5) and under para-2.5, The query of the Hon'ble commission With regard to generic tariff decided by the commission in order no. 06 of 2024 and also tariff discovered in the recent competitive bidding under taken by GUVNL wherein tariff is discovered in the range of Rs. 2.55-2.56 per unit, the representative appearing on behalf of the Petitioner has submitted that the same is required to be put up before the competent authority for their consideration and supporting documents attach herewith.
2. It would be apt to mention that PM-KUSUM - C FLS has to be implemented as per the guidelines issued by MNRE, time to time, which includes Agriculture consumers having contract demand upto 7.5 HP, use of DCR cells/ modules having ALMM registration etc.

Since, with the above guidelines, the plants are required to be set up at pre-specified locations, which has significant impact on land pricing. Time line for TN-03, are as under:

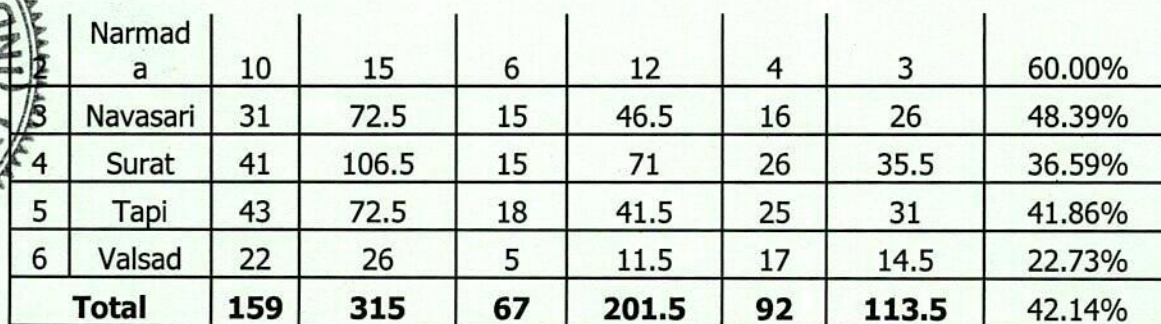
From the above table it can be seen that

- less than 50% participation is received in the plants having notified capacity of 0.5, 1.0, 1.5 MW due to the various reasons including the Inverter capacity/ transformer capacity /evacuation infrastructure capacity causes overheads.
- 100% participation of the bidders is received in the plants having notified capacity of 3.5, 4.0, 5.0, 5.5, 7.5, 8.0 MW.

4. Analysis of the Bidder's participation received in various Districts:

- less than 50% participation is received in the plants situated in Navasari, Surat, Tapi, Valsad District.
- more than 50% participation of the bidders is received in the plants situated in Bharuch, Narmada District
- Cost of the land at preferred location i.e. nearby the notified substations plays important role in CAPEX of the plant and hence the tariff is also depend upon the cost of the land parcels

From above table, it can be seen that due to various factors as mentioned above, the total 64 bidders have accepted the LOI for 160 MW and out of that, 19.5 MW are having tariff rate upto Rs. 2.76 per unit, while the Weightage average tariff for the 160 MW is Rs. 2.91.



7. Petitioner respectfully submits that this petition is filed based on the tender TN-03 which was floated on dtd.01-03-2024 as per the allocation of the MNRE dtd.20-12-23 and GUVNL allocation dtd.23-1-24 which was based on the directives issued by the MNRE time to time. It would be apt to mention that PM-KUSUM - C FLS has to be implemented as per the guidelines issued by MNRE, time to time, which includes Agriculture consumers having contract demand up to 7.5 HP, **use of Domestically manufactured Solar Cell** with Domestically manufactured Solar Modules having ALMM registration. It would be apt to mention that, MNRE vide letter dated 14-2-24, exempted the use of DCR cells for the projects for which LOAs are issued up to 31.03.2024. Therefore, for the participating bidders in this tender are required to use Domestically manufactured Solar PV cell and domestically manufactured Solar PV module only along with ALMM. **Therefore, the tender response in price bid may be reflecting overall project cost with the stipulated compliances etc.**

The main objective of the scheme is to solarize the agriculture load through decentralized renewable energy power and to provide day time power to the Ag consumers. Since, with the scheme guidelines, **the plants are required to be set up at pre-specified locations where the solarization of AG Consumers up to 7.5 HP is required, which has a significant impact on land pricing.**

Also detail justification put up in board meeting

- Impact of the 73AA Act: - The 73AA Act has specific provisions that impact land use in certain regions, including South Gujarat. This legislation imposes additional restrictions and regulatory requirements for acquiring and utilizing land for solar projects, which can lead to higher compliance costs and delays in project execution. To account for these challenges, a higher tariff rate of ₹3.00 per kWh is justified to ensure that solar projects remain financially viable despite these constraints.
- Shortage of Land and western hilly area in South Gujarat:- South Gujarat faces a significant shortage of available land suitable for solar plant installations. This scarcity drives up land prices and limits the availability of large contiguous plots necessary for efficient solar farm setups. As a result, developers incur higher costs in both acquiring land and potentially modifying project designs to fit smaller or dispersed plots. The proposed tariff rate of ₹3.00 per kWh reflects these increased costs, ensuring that projects can still deliver reasonable returns despite the challenging land availability. --- This justification highlights the critical factors of legal and geographical challenges, making a strong case for the proposed tariff rate.
- Moreover DGVCL has Coastal area, Industrial corridor, 80% of Industrial Zone, Union territory & Maharashtra border, Land cost compare to very high and geographical area is different than other region in Gujarat.

8 Petitioner also respectfully submits that in case of petition no.2403 of 2024 filed by the GUVNL for adoption of tariff for procurement of power from solar power project under section 63 of Electricity Act 2003, where it is pointed out that the discovered tariff in the range of Rs.2.55 per unit to Rs.2.56 per unit having guaranteed CUF in the range of 22%-30%. As per the daily order dtd.30-11-2024, tariff of L-1 bidder of Rs.2.55 to Rs.2.56 per unit for the project capacity ranging from 10 MW to 240 MW is mentioned.

In this regard, it may be that for the projects under petition No. 2403 of 2024 filed by the GUVNL, the requirement will not be area specific as in the case of PM KUSUM-C FLS scheme. Moreover, other requirements are limited up to adherence to ALMM standard laid down by the MNRE and as there is no any financial support /subsidy, no requirement of DCR cell would be mandated for the projects under these GUVNL petition. Moreover, the benefits of economics of scale for the projects under petition No. 2403 of 2024 of GUVNL where project capacity is ranging from minimum 10 MW to 240 MW also plays an important role on price discovery.

Moreover, if we add @ Rs.0.84 per Kwh towards the Transmission Charges , @ Rs. 0.72 per Kwh and Transmission loss @ Rs. 0.12 per Kwh, the tariff would become Rs. 3.39 per Kwh; So the tariff approval for rate upto Rs. 3.00 per Kwh for this decentralized power asked by the petitioner is much less than that.

Also, GUVNL tender is having different modality then that of DGVCL tender of PM KUSUM-C FLS scheme. GUVNL tender is of total 500MW capacity and as per the tender provision minimum 10MW for Gujarat based projects and minimum 50MW for out of Gujarat based projects were allowed. The location for injection point is not specified. These provisions are different than that of the petitioner's project requirements where DCR cell requirement is mandatory, Project capacity is limited in the range of 0.5 MW to 4 MW for each project at 11KV level injection, all the projects are and connectivity for respective sub-station were already specified with prior technical feasibility from transmission utility (GETCO) and thus, there was limited flexibility in selection of project site in case of PM KUSUM-C FLS projects. Due to this, bidders under PM KUSUM-C FLS tenders were required to select the project site nearby the sub-station notified by the DGVCL in the tender TN-03.

Therefore, in view of the above, the price discovered by GUVNL and price discovered under tender TN-03 of DGVCL, are not appropriate to compare.

9. The Petitioner most respectfully and humbly submits that as directed by the Hon'ble Commission, the Petitioner has published the Public Notice inviting Comments/Suggestions from the Stakeholders on the petition registered as 2409 of 2024, in the matter of adoption of tariff discovered under tariff based competitive bidding process conducted by DGVCL vide RfS No. DGVCL/ C&R/ DSM/ PM-KUSUM-C-FLS/TN-03 for 64 Nos of solar plants of total 160.0 MW, through RESCO model, for solarization of various 11 KV feeders in DGVCL for implementation of FLS (Feeder Level Solarization) under PM KUSUM-C scheme of Government of India, on Dated 14thDecember, 2024 in an English newspaper "Indian Express" and Gujarati newspapers "Sandesh" and Gujarati newspaper "Gujarat Samachar" having wide circulation in the state. The Cutting of the relevant newspapers dated 14.12.2024 are marked as **Annexure I**. It is stated that the Petition has also been uploaded on the website of DGVCL and the copy of the relevant snapshot of the website is attached hereto and marked as **Annexure II**

Further, the petitioner humbly submits that from the date of issue of public notice, up to dtd. 24-12-2024, there is no any comments / suggestions / objections are received from stakeholders by the petitioner.

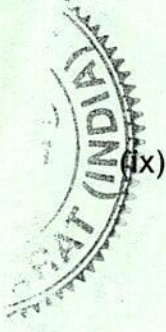
Further, petitioner respectfully submits that in respect of point 3.7 of daily order dtd.20-12-2024, the petitioner has already placed on record the documents listed under (i) to (ix) in the petition filed by the petitioner on dt.2-12-24 in affidavit. The point wise details are as under;

- (ii) In respect of consolidated statement containing details of amendment issued in each Tender from time to time after its publication mentioning justification for bringing such amendment and confirmation that subsequent modifications in the bid documents brought in by the Petitioner from time to time was widely published for intimating to all prospective bidders and also confirmation that bid documents along with amendment issue from time to time is in consonance with MNRE guidelines is placed on record from page no.1190 to 1195.
- (iii) In respect of copy of Supporting documents to confirm the date on which



Technical Bid Evaluation Report, Financial Bid Evaluation Report and Price Bid Evaluation Report for each bid was prepared by Bid Evaluation Committee is placed on record vide Bid committee reports as under;

with MNRE guidelines is placed on record on page no.1203 to 1220.

(ix) In respect of the Petitioner has referred to the MNRE guideline dated 10.02.2022 and its amendments thereto in the Petition. However, copy of said guidelines is not placed on record in the Petition. The Petitioner is required to place on record the copy of MNRE guidelines dated 10.02.2022 and its amendments thereto as referred in the Petition, in context of this, it is to respectfully submits that the said guideline is received thorough e-mail dtd.10-02-2022 which was placed on record on page no.1237 to 1240.
